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BASIC PROPOSAL

The City Council of Escondido unanimously entered into an (MOU) Memorandum of Understanding with The Rinks Foundation (TRF), proposing the following:

- A 16-acre Ice Complex with three rinks
- A practice space for the SD Gulls
- 3,000 spectator seats
- 430 new parking spaces
- A restaurant
- Retail space

WHAT IS AFFECTED

Several communities, activities, and green space are affected, lost or being displaced.

- 4 Softball fields, hosting 75 teams, four nights per week
- Soccer fields at Ryan Park will be removed to accommodate new softball fields
- 1,000+ people per week at KCP who use and enjoy these fields
- Trees, trails, open green space will be lost
- Wildlife and native vegetation
- More traffic, congestion, safety concerns

TRANSPARENCY, ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW & COMMUNITY TRUST

This is not about opposing ice sports. It is about protecting public land, ensuring a transparent decision-making process, and giving residents a meaningful voice before Kit Carson Park is committed to a long-term development agreement. We support expanding recreational and economic opportunities in Escondido, but we believe this is the wrong location for this project.

Kit Carson Park belongs to the people of Escondido. A long-term lease of public parkland should not be rushed or approved before residents fully understand the project's impacts, costs, risks, and alternatives. A project of this scale deserves transparency, environmental review, careful consideration, and community trust.
